## **How does the selection process work?**

After submitting your online application, your profile and motivation will be screened. If you pass the initial review, you will be invited for an in-depth personal interview with the mindset trainer.

Each seat represents one month of our mission: world peace within 24 months. This symbolic number also guarantees a highly intimate, secure, and premium group dynamic.

## **Who funds the scholarships for the Young Heroes?**

Scholarships for our young heroes are fully funded by the corporate fees of the world leaders and through external partnerships. This ensures equal collaboration on Zanzibar.

## **What is the exact location in Zanzibar?**

The training takes place at a secluded, high-end executive resort on the coast of Zanzibar. This guarantees absolute privacy, focus, and security for all participants. The exact location will be shared upon admission.

## **What happens after the 5-day kick-off?**

Zanzibar is just the starting gun. Once the kick-off ends, the 24-month clock begins. The 24 participants will remain closely connected through a structured framework of online peer reviews, progress tracking, and strategic support.
